This would avoid training on 3 consecutive weekends as the attendees would have worked 20 consecutive days without a break. The quote to carry out as above is \$24,200.00 plus taxes.
 - There appears to be some debate if the HAZWOPER training is required for the worker operating the HHW.

- Environment has recently advised that the individual worker does not require Hazwoper training however at least one representative from CRSB must be trained. Committee recommended that all workers be trained.
- BNG recommendation is to train all workers in Hazwoper
- The TDG and Whimis completed

- The expected start date for HHW is May 6, 2013
