- **Staff Training** 
  - TDG, Whimis, Hazwoper
  - Atlantic recommended that that the TDG course and WHMIS course be held first for a one day delivery on a Monday. The next weekend the first 2 days of the HAZWOPER and then either 2 or 3 weeks later, the last 2 days of the HAZWOPER delivery. This would avoid training on 3 consecutive weekends as the attendees would have worked 20 consecutive days without a break. The quote to carry out as above is \$24,200.00 plus taxes.
  - There appears to be some debate if the HAZWOPER training is required for the worker operating the HHW.
  - Environment has recently advised that the individual worker does not require Hazwoper training however at least one representative from CRSB must be trained. Committee recommended that all workers be trained.
  - BNG recommendation is to train all workers in Hazwoper
  - The TDG and Whimis completed
  - CRSB will work with MMSB to promote the HHW program
  - The expected start date for HHW is May 6, 2013
- Certificate of Approval to Collect and Transport HHW for DOE
  - Operations and Emergency response plan being developed
