- Work to be completed this fall or early winter. Results needed to complete design of buildings.

Well Drilling

Results needed to complete design of buildings mechanical systems.

Site Buildings

- Design drawings 80% completed on Scale House, Public Drop-off Area, and Maintenance Garage
- Design Brief prepared for buildings mechanical systems. Need approval before we can start the mechanical design.
- cost benefit analysis on green items competed and forwarded to Cory Grandy
- Committee reviewed and recommend that the consultant include all energy conservation aspects to be included in the design package for site buildings as we want to keep this project green.

Clearing and Grubbing

- Request for funding from Municipal Affairs is required to move forward with LWMF's. We will discuss with Cory.

Geotechnical

- Boreholes and test pits to be completed on each site prior to completing building

design. Work has to be completed this fall or early winter.

Well Drilling

- Tender documents being prepared. Wells have to be drilled and yield determined prior to completing building design. Work has to be done this fall or early winter.

Site Buildings

- Preliminary drawings package completed on one transfer site. Drawings underway on others.

C & D Sites

- No decisions from the Provincial Government on this item at this time. They are working on it.

Crown Lands Application

- Buchan's Junction Approval received from Crown Lands. Legal survey being prepared.
- Point Leamington -Not Crown Land
 - Town has been asked to provide land to CNWMA
- New World Island/Twillingate Reduced area required to 11 ha. Silviculture has been asked to reassess.
- Fogo Island Forestry has been approved. Compensation required from forestry is approximately \$ 7,000.
 - Approval received from Crown Lands.
- Gander Bay –Forestry has approved
 - Waiting on Crown Lands for approval to do legal survey.
- Indian Bay Crown Land waiting on reply from Abitibi.
- Terra Nova Approval received from Crown Lands.

4. Lewisporte Interim Waste Disposal Study

- Study complete and draft report issued.
- CNWMC and BNG will meet with the Town to discuss the next steps.

- Operation of site responsibility of Fogo Regional Council

6. Fogo Island Transfer Station

- Funding approved is \$436,000

- Site Location confirmed
- Forestry approved. Compensation to be paid (\$7,000)
- Waiting on Crown Land approval to do legal surveys
- Approval requested to extend Regional Site clearing and grubbing contract include Fogo Interim site. Contractor (Woodco) is willing to accept. We may have to go to Public Tender.

Items Discussed

CP2 – The Tender Document will be on your desk on Monday 22nd of September.
 Approval is required and hopefully the tender will be in the Saturday Evening Telegram.
 Wayne is prepared to meet with Cory to review the document if required.

Cory will do his best to move this project forward.

The work attached to CP2 will allow BNG to complete the Geotechnical required for the Building Design on the Regional Site. These Tender packages will be finalized over the Winter for approval for Spring construction.

- 2. Additional Capital costs for Green Footprint Cory will be provided with a list of Green (Environmentally Friendly) items in the development of the Regional site. Payback time table will also be provided. The Technical Committee will pursue the Green theme for the Regional site.
- 3. Project Sign BNG has forwarded another design. Cory still has some concerns on the design. Wayne has requested Cory to identify the issues so he can get the final design completed and have the sign constructed.
- 4. Clearing and Grubbing Contract for LWMF The CNWM will be requesting approval of the Tender document for Clearing and Grubbing and Road Work for all the LWMF. To meet June 2010 start up operations, this work must be started this Fall and completed early Spring to help move the other construction elements required for LWMF's.
- Fogo This issue of payment to Forestry for reimbursement on Fogo Island needs to be resolved. Cory will review and give some guidance. We recommend payment ASAP to move this development along.
- 6. Twillingate & Change Islands They both have Tee Pee Incineration. If these two operations are shut down December 31, 2008, there options available and related costs need to be developed. BNG has submitted cost associated with these studies. Approval is required from Municipal Affairs.
- 7. C & D Locations WE require a decision on the permitted C & D site locations. This is being worked on by the various Government Departments involved.
