- Gary Revised the Programs of MMSB, including waste reduction, waste diversion and recycling; Education programming and the waste management trust fund.

- MMSB oversaw the regulations of the Beverage Programs and Used Tires Programs, and over oversite of the Extended Procedures Program (EPR) of waste paint, electronic waste, and used oil/glycol programs.

- MMSB is now looking at, with the input of Regional Service Boards (RSB's) and EPR approach to Packaging and Paper Producers Recycling. A consultation session will be held in St. John's on June 2, 2022. There are five (5) seats available for CNWM.

Wood Fiber – Fogo Island

- From October 2021 – May 18, 2022 – 3,196 tonnes have ben removed at a cost of \$207,740.00. Removal of the wood fiber on Fogo Island is ongoing.

Review process of WRWM 2020-2021 – Tip Fee

- WRSB has communicated to Central that they will continue to pay the 2019 tip fee of \$28.77 until such a time as the Departments of Environment and Climate Change and Department of Municipal and Provincial Affairs comes forward with a clear path and meet with both Boards.

CRSB will do a letter to both Departments outlining the concerns of Central residents subsidizing the cost of waste disposal for residents of Western.
