-Update of wood fiber removal – Fogo Island: Removal began on October 6th, 23 loads removed totaling 293 tonnes. About 40 tonnes was new wood fiber coming to the Transfer Station on Fogo Island.

-Proposal for new Tractor Truck with Grapple. The Dept. of ECC has offered, through Ultimate Gas Tax Program at 70/30 split to a maximum of \$700,000.00

MOTION: Moved by D. White that we accept the Dept. of Municipal andProvincial Affairs offer and apply through the Capital Investment Plan forfinancial assistance. CRSB will contribute 30% to a maximum of \$300,000.00 inthe purchase of this piece of equipment. Seconded by P. FarwellM.C

MOTION: moved by D. Luff that CRSB go to tender on the Tractor Truck with Grapple. Seconded by G. Arnold. <u>M.C</u>

-Proposal on New Maintenance Garage, Wash Bay.

The Tender Package with Drawings for the Proposed New Maintenance Garage and Wash Bay has been completed by the Consulting/Engineering Firm at a cost paid totally by CRSB.

MOTION: Moved by D. White that CRSB request financial assistance from the Dept. of Municipal and Provincial Affairs under the Capital Investment Plan, and CRSB provide up to 30% for engineering, construction cost etc. of the proposed Maintenance Garage, Wash Bay. Seconded by L Picket.

Other Business

Provincial Government announces Mandatory Vaccination Policy. The directive applies to Government Agencies, Boards and Commissions. As a Regional Service Board, we are required to follow this directive.

As well, the policy will also apply to Contractors that CRSB deals with.

-D. White indicated the CRSB may get a request to provide curbside collection from the Town of Lewisporte, to Begin January 2023.

-P. Farwell suggest that CRSB review the Federal CANOE PAA of Canada for better tender pricing on goods and equipment.

-M. Attwood will be looking at a potential tender package for used compactors. Both compactors provide high repair cost, and a new one is required, to be reviewed at the next board meeting.
